

Suggested Items to Have Ready

You need to be prepared to be gone for up to 16 days. Do not bring anything of value, or that you are uncomfortable leaving in camp unattended. Pack your gear in heavy duty duffle bag or Rubbermaid container (mice, dust and water proof). Take what you need, but pack compact and light.

* Required

Personal Gear:16 days of undergarments (underwear, socks, undershirt)Basic toiletries of your preference (Soap, toothbrush and toothpaste)Sun Screen, Chap Stick, Hand Lotion (shorts, coat, sweatshirt)Casual camp fatigue (tennis shoes, sweats, jeans) (thongs/sandals for shower use)Towel(s)Washcloth(s)Ear Plugs for sleepingCalling cardCash/Money*Air Bourne, Vitamins, Various Medicines for Camp Crud, Foot careEntertainment: Reading material or DVD player

Camping Gear:

Rubbermaid container or heavy duty duffle bag for storage of gear		
Alarm Clock	*Flashlights	(That Uses AA Batteries)

Work Gear:

- *Minimum 1 pair of sunglasses (cheap) 1 Pair leather work gloves
- * Heavy duty work belt
- Neck Scarf's and handkerchiefs
- * Work Boots, Leather Lace up with lug sole, min 8" top, (extra laces) have them broke in by fire season!
- * Nomex (Shirts and Pants) Supplied by EWST if needed (Check EBay for your own pair, or contact EWST)

Mandatory Gear:

* Drivers License (or photo identification)

* DOT Medical/Health Card (Required for ENGB's, can NOT dive engine without it)
